1. Is the KED Program compatible with CBSE?

Yes. The KED Program is completely aligned with the CBSE curriculum. We follow CBSE learning outcomes and assessment guidelines but deliver them through the personalised, student-centric KED methodology. What NEP is now implementing is an integrated approach; the KED Programme has already been working around it since 2013.

2. How has Kunskapsskolan restructured the school curriculum and pedagogy as per the National Education Policy 2020?

Pre-nursery – Grade 2	5 years Foundational +	Foundational Stage lays emphasis on play/activity-based learning and follows the curriculum and pedagogy of ECCE. Focus is largely play-based, activity-based and inquiry-based. This holistic approach ensures that foundational literacy and numeracy are developed alongside social, emotional, ethical, physical, and creative growth, providing a strong base for lifelong learning.
Grades 3-5	3 years Preparatory+	The Preparatory Stage transitions gradually from play-based learning to more formal but interactive learning. The aim is to consolidate foundational skills while nurturing curiosity, conceptual understanding,

		collaboration, creativity, and independent thinking, preparing learners for the subject-based learning of the Middle Stage. We have various hands-on projects etc. in the form of presentations that are mapped to the KED-CBSE way.
Grades 6-8	3 years Middle+	Middle School focuses around learning/discussions of abstract concepts across science, math, arts and social science and humanities, but with greater depth, greater flexibility and students' choice. This is taken forward through a multidisciplinary approach. Students engage in deeper multidisciplinary learning, greater student choice, advanced critical thinking, and exploration of future academic and career pathways. At KED we take it forward through steps and themes.
Grades 9-10 & 11-12	4 years of High School	High School allows exposure to more subjects and enables greater flexibility. Exploration of relations between different Subjects. Each student graduates with a balanced combination of deep disciplinary knowledge, 21st-century competencies, flexibility in learning, and readiness for higher education, work, and life. At Kunskapsskolan, there is a detailed process of subject selection where we do not have streams but are open to various subject combinations. We work around skills for the future and encourage students to work with NGOs and do internships during these years.

3. How do the KED and NCERT/CBSE align?

They align very well as NCERT/ CBSE is the 'what' of the curriculum and the approach to assessment, and KED is the 'how' or the 'way' curriculum is delivered.

As per the National Education Policy, CBSE introduced a new academic structure in 2020, which the KED program has always been following:

4. How is the CBSE syllabus taught under the KED model?

The CBSE syllabus is delivered through:

- **Learning Portals** that provide resources mapped to CBSE Learning outcomes.
- **Personal Coaching** to meet curriculum goals at an individual pace, using personalised plans.
- **Teacher-Led Sessions** for core concepts.
- **Workshops and Labs sessions** for practice and reinforcement.

5. How are assessments conducted?

Assessments follow CBSE's prescribed formats and as a KED school, we supplement it with:

- Step and Theme Presentations
- Use various Assessment for Learning tools like Quiz, Role play
- Research Work, Projects and portfolios
- Regular Goal reviews with personal coaches to ensure a deeper understanding and progress tracking.

6. What role do teachers play in the KED-CBSE model?

Teachers act as **personal coaches**, guiding students through weekly one-on-one sessions. They help set academic goals, monitor progress, and support personal development while also delivering structured lessons as per CBSE norms. A KED CBSE teacher is:

- A subject teacher
- Personal Coach
- General teacher
- Workshop teacher

7. From what grade is the KED Program implemented?

The KED Program is implemented from Pre-Primary through Grade 12. In KED India schools, the CBSE curriculum is offered using the KED approach in all these grades.

8. How do students benefit from the KED approach in a CBSE setting?

Students become:

- **Independent learners**
- **Critical thinkers**
- **Better problem-solvers**
- **Effective time managers**
- **Confident communicators**
- **Reflective Individuals**

This personalized approach prepares them for academic success and life beyond school.

9. What streams do you offer in grades 11 and 12?

CBSE does not encourage streams – it encourages a combination of subjects. At Kunskapsskolan, we have always encouraged students to choose different subject combinations based on their aptitude, interests, and effort. An internal policy governs the choice and combination of subjects. For example; assessment of aptitude and year-long successful performance in the subject in Grades IX and X, including the Board Examinations, is evaluated against a set criterion.
